Design Concept

- The key aim of the project is to transform a currently underused corner of the school playing field into a destination for learning and exploration by the school and neighbouring schools & community groups.
- A wide range of habitats will encourage a diverse range of flora and fauna to live, roost and feed in the wildlife garden
- Its construction and maintenance with be jointly carried out by contractors, pupils, parents, teacher and neighbouring community groups.
- The pond will be fenced and used under supervision only, however, the rest of the garden will be accessible at all times during the day.
- The space will continue to evolve and adapt to the requirements of the school and its neighbour over time. Regular community events will be held to build upon the design and to maintain the space to ensure it continues to be a long term sustainable resource.
